

ROOMMATE DISCUSSION TOPICS

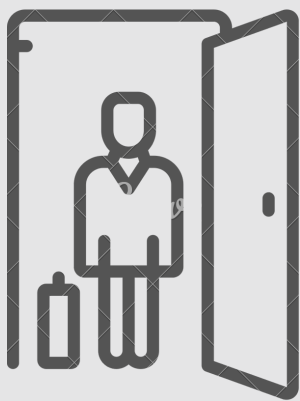
It's important to make sure you and your roommates are all in agreement about your living space. Below are some topics to discuss.

CLEANING

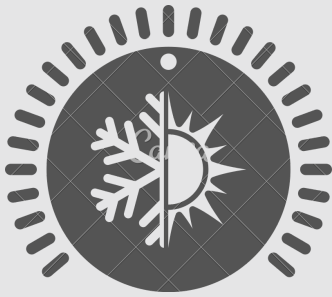
It's important to outline when cleaning should take place and to confirm expectations of cleanliness in shared spaces. Make a schedule of who is responsible for cleaning, taking out the garbage, doing dishes and when this should all happen.

GUESTS AND VISITORS

Guest policies within residence will be modified to fit changing provincial health regulations. Outside of the policies put in place, what are your expectations from each other. Discuss your comfort levels with outside guests, fellow residents in the community, and family members

ROOM TEMPERATURE

Each residence unit has one thermostat that controls the temperature in the entire unit. Discuss your preferred temperature levels (colder or warmer). After you both agree discuss a specific temperature range you would like the room to be kept.

SHARED ITEMS

Discuss what you will be bringing with you to residence. Are there items you would like to share with your roommate? It's also important to discuss roles for purchasing replacement items. Who will be purchasing toilet tissue, cleaning products, hand soap, dish soap, etc.?
